

The B.C. “Chinese Bridge” Mandarin Speech Contest is organized by the Education Office, Consulate General of The People’s Republic of China in Vancouver and co-organized by the BC Chinese language teaching professionals. The purpose of this contest is to promote multiculturalism and Chinese language and culture learning.

TOPIC: **I Have a Dream**

CATEGORIES: The contest will be divided by 6 categories:

1. Non-heritage Speakers - Elementary Level (1-2 years of study)
2. Non-heritage Speakers -Intermediate - Advanced level (3 years and above)
3. Non-heritage Speakers (International/Exchange Students/ other adult learners)
4. Heritage Beginners Born Overseas
5. Native Cantonese Speaker –Elementary Level
6. Native Cantonese Speaker –Intermediate-Advanced Level

CONTEST PROCEDURE AND RULES:

1. Length of speech: 3 minutes
2. Selection: 3 winners will be chosen from each category. For Categories with fewer than 6 contestants (including 6), 1-2 winners will be selected.
3. Evaluation Criteria: pronunciation, intonation, grammar, vocabulary, content and style of delivery.
4. Qualification: Heritage and Cantonese speakers must present birth certificates before the contest.
5. Speakers must focus on the designated topic. The organizers reserve the rights to terminate any irrelevant speeches. The contest will be conducted in alphabetical order by the first letter of the contestants’ surnames (A-Z).
6. If the first prize winner of the 2011 “Chinese Bridge” Mandarin Speech Contest will sign up for the same category this year and win the first prize again, then the competitor will be awarded as a “Special Award”.

5. 母语粤语组（初级，需提供出生证明）
6. 母语粤语组（中、高级，需提供出生证明）

比赛程序与规则：

1. 演讲时间：3分钟。
2. 评奖：每组决出前3名优胜者分获一、二、三等奖。如果每组人数不足6人时(包括6人)，优胜者人数为1-2人。
3. 评审标准：语音语调，词汇语法，演讲内容，表达技巧。
4. 比赛资格：华裔土生以及母语为粤语的参赛者需提供出生证。
5. 比赛规则：演讲必须紧扣主题。主办方有权随时中止与主题无关的演讲。比赛出场顺序按各组参赛者姓氏的第一英文字母编排(A-Z)。
6. 参加过2011年度汉语桥演讲比赛并获一等奖的选手，如今年报名同一组别及比赛成绩仍为第一名者，将被授予特别奖。
